Gypsy Lee Pierce Keffer passed away peacefully in her sleep on December 26, 2016 in Providence Hospital, Mobile, Alabama. Born December 16, 1936 in Lee Co., Mississippi to Carl Leland Pierce and Ruby May Hall Pierce, Gypsy lived a majority of her childhood in south Alabama. In 1957, she married Thomas Henry Keffer and moved to Terrell, Texas, where she gave birth to her daughter and first son.
