Deborah Auld Collier, age 60, resident of Grand Bay, AL, passed away in the early morning hours of December 3rd, 2016. Debbie was born in McIntosh County on Georgia's east coast on December 14, 1955. In 1973 she graduated from McIntosh County Academy and her family moved to Bayou La Batre, Alabama, where her father hoped to build a better future. This is where she met Gary Collier and they fell in love and were married on June 9th, 1976. Together they had 5 children, 12 grandchildren, and 2 great-grandchildren. Debbie loved to "ride around the beach" along Bayou La Batre and Coden's bayou, then along the sea wall. Something she learned to love in the early years of moving to Alabama was riding the sea walls, hoping to see the right boat in the channel. She would ride for hours, often stopping to collect sea shells or a plant she thought was beautiful.
