Neill Langston, 44, tragically passed away on Thursday, May 3, 2018, after a massive heart attack. The family will visit with friends on Saturday, May 5, 2018 from 5:00 – 7:00 p.m. in the Sanctuary at Perry United Methodist Church. Funeral Services will be held on Sunday, May 6, 2018 at 2:00 p.m. at Perry United Methodist Church with interment to follow at Evergreen Cemetery.
