Boyd Wayne Headley, 74, passed away peacefully at his home on Saturday, April 7, 2018, surrounded by his loving and devoted family. A Graveside Service will be held on Monday, April 9, 2018, at 1:00 p.m. in Elko Cemetery. Immediately following the service, Mr. Headley will be temporarily entombed in the Dogwood Mausoleum at Perry Memorial Gardens awaiting construction of the Headley Mausoleum at Elko Cemetery where he will be permanently entombed. As a young adult, he attended Ford Auto Mechanic School, graduating first in his class, and received the honor of 5-Star Mechanic. He moved his family to Perry in 1970 to care for his parents who were living in Macon. He began working in the Service Department at Moody Motor Company as well as in the Maintenance Department at Pabst Brewing Company. A hard-working man, Wayne was always busy with 2 or 3 jobs to support his family as much as he could. He continued at Moody Motor Company, eventually bought the repair business from Mr. Moody where he enjoyed auto mechanic work and owned several other auto repair businesses through the years. Wayne also stayed with Pabst, then G. Heileman Brewing Co., then Stroh's, working his way to Management in the Maintenance Department. Additionally, Cagle's and Perdue Farms kept Wayne employed until his retirement in 2014. Wayne loved spending time with his family and friends and always loved family reunions and holiday celebrations. He was the "King of Crock Pots" and held a picnic to barbecue a goat every year on July 4th, a tradition that had been started by his father. Christmas was his favorite holiday.
