BROKEN ARROW, OKLAHOMA -Trey Hamsley, 31, passed away unexpectedly on Saturday, January 14, 2017. Visitation will be on Thursday, January 19, 2017, from 5:00 until 7:00 p.m. at Watson-Hunt Funeral Home in Perry, GA.
