AUGUSTA- Samuel Richard Walker, a retired contractor, passed away on Monday, September 7, 2015, at the age of 84. He reached his goal and has received his reward on Heaven's bright shore. A Visitation will be held on Friday, September 11, 2015, from 7:00 until 9:00 p.m. at the Christ's Sanctified Holy Church in Perry, Georgia. Funeral Services will be held on Saturday, September 12, 2015, at 2:00 p.m. at Christ's Sanctified Holy Church. Interment will be in the Church Cemetery immediately following the service.
