Harvey Keith Garrett, 52, passed away on Sunday, January 4, 2015, after an extended illness. Funeral Services will be held on Tuesday, January 6, 2015, at 2:00 p.m. at Perry United Methodist Church. A Private Interment will be in Oglethorpe City Cemetery immediately following the service. The family will receive friends on Tuesday, January 6, 2015, from 1:00 until 2:00 p.m., the hour preceding the service, in the Fellowship Hall at Perry United Methodist Church.
