Wilbur Lynn "Pete" Campbell, after celebrating a beautiful earthly life of 67 years, went to his heavenly home on Wednesday, August 14, 2013. Mr. Campbell proudly served in the U. S. Navy from 1960 to 1968, receiving an honorable discharge, and was a member of the American Legion Post 24. He held a steam engineers license, and was an amateur radio operator. He was preceded in death by his parents.
