Verna Mae Young Brewer, 88, passed away peacefully on Sunday, January 26, 2020, exactly 37 years after her husband died. Services will be held on Thursday, January 30, 2020, with the Visitation at 2:00 p.m. and the Funeral at 3:00 p.m. at Houston Lake Baptist Church with Reverend Fred McCoy officiating. Interment will be in Magnolia Park Cemetery immediately following the service.
