Robin Jones Smith, 50, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, May 5, 2020, after a brief but strong battle with cancer. She and her family moved there just weeks before being diagnosed with cancer in December 2019. She loved God, was passionate about her family, truly enjoyed working, and loved her Georgia football.
