Perry, Georgia- John Greer Lasseter died suddenly on Saturday, June 27th, 2020, after a lifetime of love for his family and friends.

Greer was a gift to the world in all respects. He was a loving, dedicated husband to his wife, Lori, and an outstanding father of two wonderful children, Kristen and John Randall. A devoted son-in-law to Martha Randall, and brother to Lee Lasseter and Jeff Lasseter, both of Perry, Georgia. Greer's laugh was infectious, his smile unparalleled.
