Jonathan Craig Simons was born on January 17, 1964, and fell into the arms of Jesus on Monday, July 6, 2020. Craig's life will be celebrated on Friday, July 10, 2020, at 7:00 p.m. in the Chapel at Watson-Hunt Funeral Home in Perry, Georgia. The family will receive friends one hour prior to the service. A Graveside will be held on Saturday, July 11, 2020, at 11:00 a.m. at Christ's Sanctified Holy Church Campground Cemetery. He was a hard worker and could work circles around most, especially if he was doing it for others. He donated his time, resources, and energy to help those in need when he could. No matter what challenge Craig faced, he never gave up. His reverent fear of God and humble spirit kept him on his knees. He will be dearly missed.

Craig is survived by his son, Garrett Edward Simons, his daughter, Anna Kate Simons, and their mother, Claire; his parents, Burnice and Minnie Simons; his brother and sister-in-law, Marc and Terry Simons; and his sister, Andrea Simons; along with many aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, and cousins. He was preceded in death by a stillborn son, Elijah Rooke Simons.

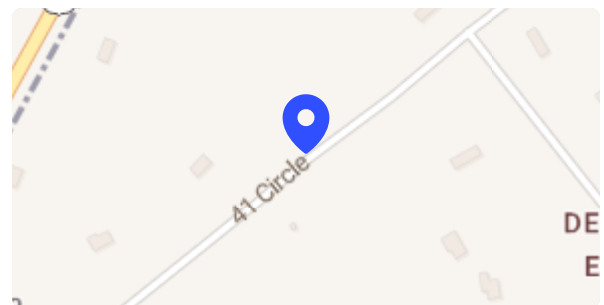

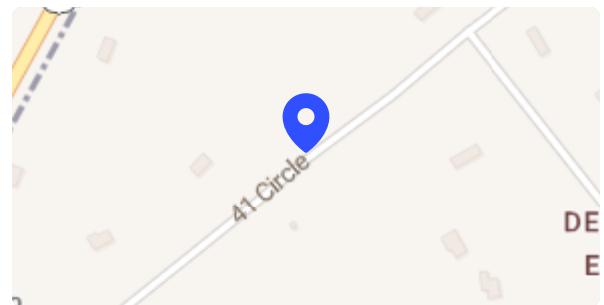

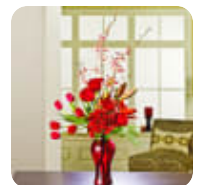
