Charles Moseley, 86 of Perry, passed away on Thursday, October 8, 2020, surrounded by his family. 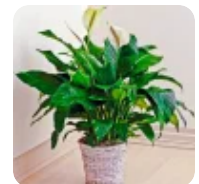
Betty Summers posted:
