DALEVILLE, ALABAMA – Robert “Bud” A. Ogletree, 62, passed away in Daleville, Alabama on Thursday, January 21, 2021. A Graveside Service will be held on Monday, January 25, 2021, at 1:00 p.m. in Perry Memorial Gardens in Perry, Georgia. Anyone is welcome to attend. 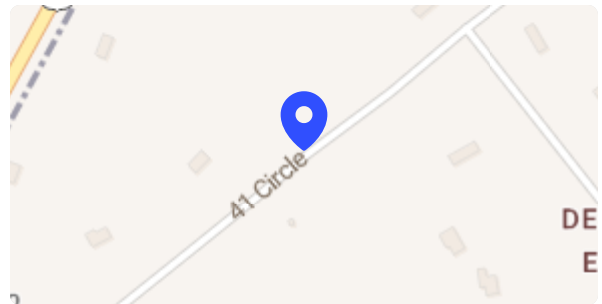

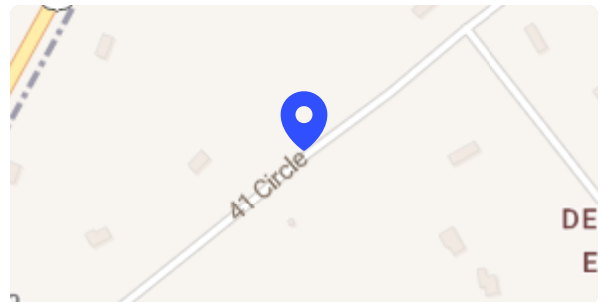

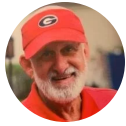
