She was a teacher in the Houston County School System and The Westfield School for a total of forty-three years. 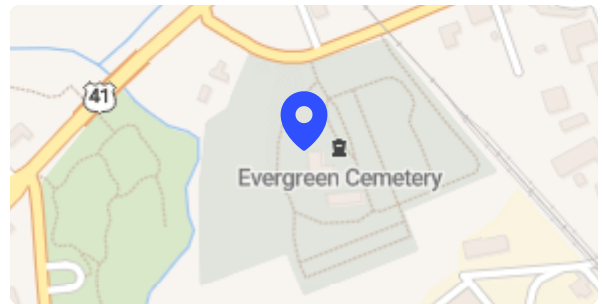

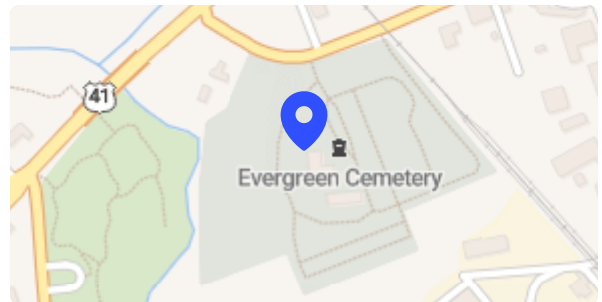
