The family will receive friends on Friday, October 15, 2021, from 4:00 until 6:00 p.m. at Cross Point Baptist Church. Funeral Services will be held on Saturday, October 16, 2021, at 11:00 a.m. at Cross Point Baptist Church with Pastors Jason Mangrum and Michael Stovall officiating. Burial will be in Perry Memorial Gardens immediately following the service. Living in Athens naturally led Shawn to becoming an avid Georgia Bulldog fan, and he loved tailgating and cheering on the Dawgs. He was really looking forward to seeing the bulldogs play at every home game this year, and he will surely be cheering from the sidelines in Heaven. Shawn's passion for people and serving others shone through all of his daily activities, whether he was working or not. He loved being around and helping others. Shawn took many beach trips with friends and spent time hiking and camping through the years. He had become a competitive fisherman and fished in several tournaments with his dad. He was a member of Cross Point Baptist Church in Perry.

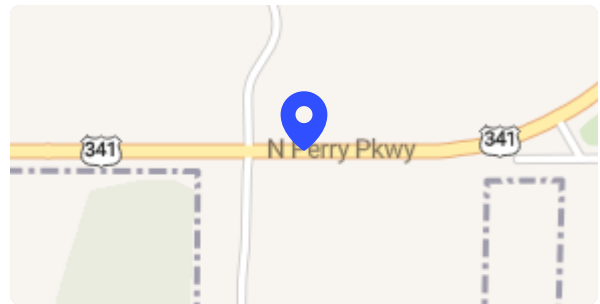

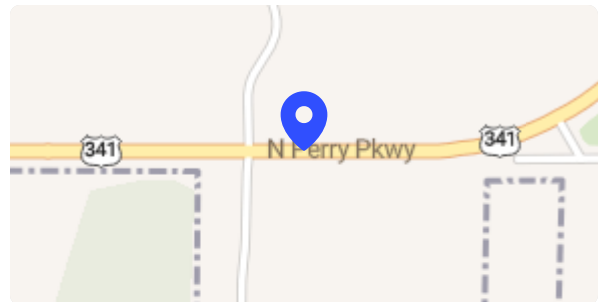

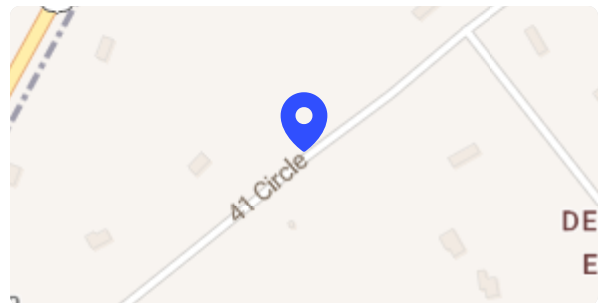
