Emma Jean accepted a position packing parachutes with Civil Service at Robins Air Force Base and retired after several years. She unexpectedly lost her young, beloved husband in 1976. She was always taking care of her family, and as her family grew, so did her love for them. Emma Jean loved spending time with her grandchildren. An artist at heart, she enjoyed painting.
