He lived in Perry and Lizella most of his life. Larry became a talented millwright, welder, and carpenter through all of the years that he worked with A & W Mechanics. In 1994, he founded Sunshine Mechanical, which he owned and operated until 2020. Larry was an outdoorsman and loved to hunt and fish. A free spirit, Larry was always bigger than life. He had a great sense of humor and made life fun for all those around him. In fact, he was usually the life of the party. Everyone loved Larry, and he had many friends from all walks of life; he never met a stranger. He was generous and gave to anyone who needed his help.
