Allen Matney Glaser, Jr., 73, passed away peacefully at a hospital in Savannah on Thursday, July 28, 2022, after an extended illness. Memorial Services will be held on Saturday, August 6, 2022, at Watson-Hunt Funeral Home. In the mid-1990's, Allen was transferred with Allstate to their office in Macon, and the family moved to Perry to be near Allen's only sibling. Allen retired from Allstate Insurance after thirty years of service. He enjoyed travelling to Savannah often to visit family and friends. A "gadget guy" at heart, he was always looking for the latest and more technologically advanced electronics with which to begin tinkering. Allen savored the moments he was able to make repairs himself around home or church. He continuously had music playing wherever he was with whatever he was doing. A huge music buff, he had extensive collections of vinyl 45 records, 8-track tapes, cassette tapes, and CDs. Some of his favorite musicians included The Spinners, Steely Dan, and Eric Clapton among many others.
