Victor Edward Slaw, 66, passed away peacefully on February 6, 2023, after an extended illness. Services will be held on Thursday, February 9, 2023, at First Baptist Church of Haynesville with the Visitation beginning at 2:00 p.m. and the Funeral starting at 3:00 p.m. Rev. Winfred Huff will be officiating. Burial will be in the church cemetery immediately following the service.

Victor was born in Dover AFB, Delaware, and moved to Warner Robins when his dad was transferred to Robins Air Force Base. He graduated from Warner Robins High School in 1974 and soon after, proudly joined the U.S. Navy. After serving there, Victor joined the Air Force Reserves and remained on active duty for a few more years.
