Doris Allen Goetz, 82, passed away peacefully on Monday, March 27, 2023. Services will be held on Friday, March 31, 2023, at Crossroads United Methodist Church. 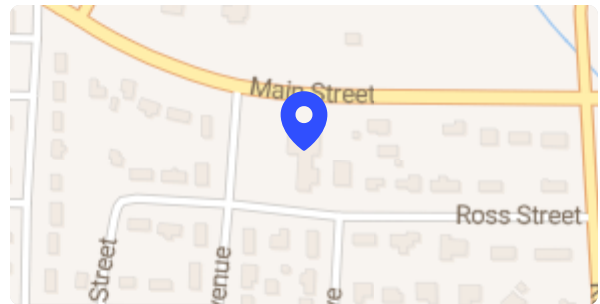

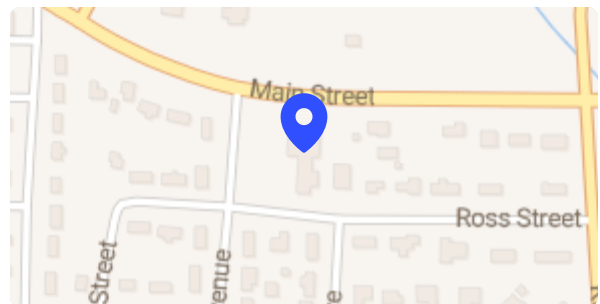

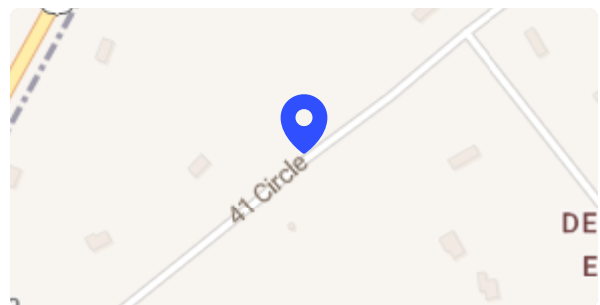
