Leroy Singleton, 80, passed away peacefully on Thursday, March 30, 2023. Services will be held on Saturday, April 1, 2023, at First Baptist Church of Haynesville with the Reverend David Fisher officiating. 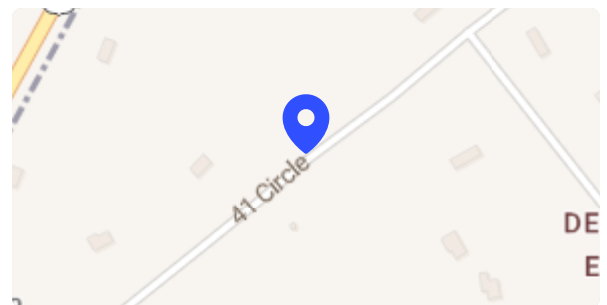
