After raising her five children, Agnes attended college, graduated with a Bachelor's Degree in Nutrition from Fort Valley State College, and earned a Master's Degree in Business Administration from the University of Georgia. She then completed a successful Civil Service career at Robins AFB from where she retired after over thirty years of service. Agnes and her husband, Theo, lived out the great commandment, "Love your neighbor as yourself." She was known for her delicious food, her wonderfully delivered stories, and her clever wit. She found joy in teaching others how to cook, can food, and/or sew. If you needed a meal, there was always one available at her home. Agnes enjoyed spending time with her family, her friends, her church, and her Red Hatters. Serving at the Shepherd's Table in Perry, "working" at the canning plant in Perry, and being anywhere she was needed always delighted Agnes. She was an avid reader and writer who published several cookbooks, compiled an in-depth family history, and wrote a weekly homespun article for the Houston Home Journal for many years. She was also a member of the local chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution.
