**C**OTTONWOOD, AL – Jeromy Wayne Hagan, 48, passed away peacefully on Sunday, July 14, 2024. Services will be held on Wednesday, July 17, 2024, at Christ’s Sanctified Holy Church. Visitation will begin at 1:00 p.m., and the funeral will begin at 2:00 p.m. Interment will be in Christ’s Sanctified Holy Church Cemetery immediately following the service.

Jeromy grew up in the greater Atlanta area and graduated from Redan High School in Stone Mountain in the Class of 1994. 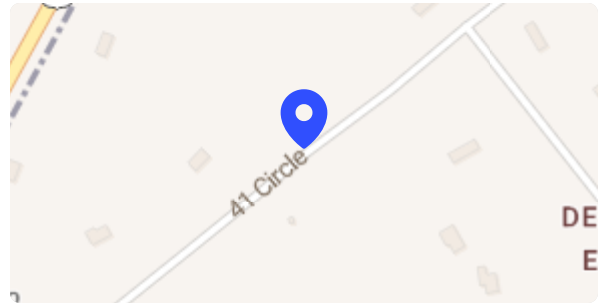

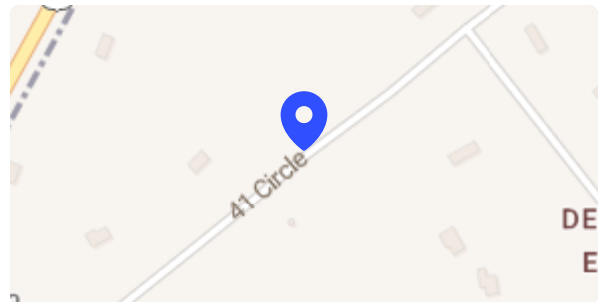

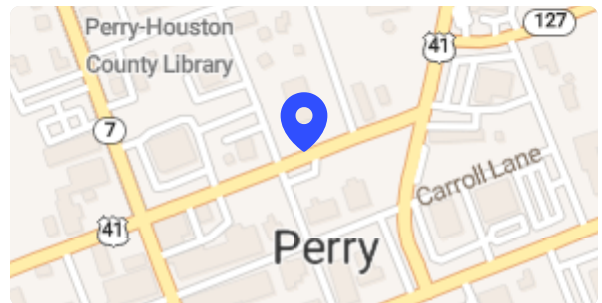
