Carl Bradley Foster, Jr., 71, passed away on Monday, January 6, 2025.

Carl was born in Norfolk, Virginia, to the late Carl Foster, Sr, and the late Louise Foster Fuller. A longtime member of Christ's Sanctified Holy Church, he became Sanctified at a young age. 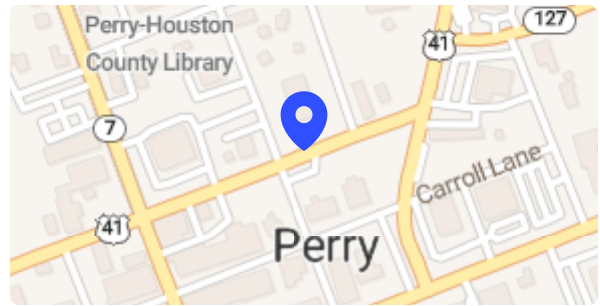

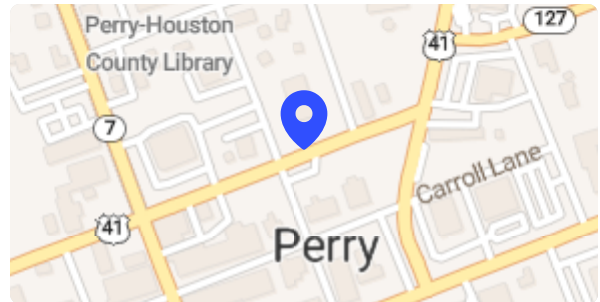
