Daniel Grayson Hart Adams, known to most as Danny, passed away peacefully at home on Monday, August 4, 2025, after a long and difficult medical journey. He was surrounded by love and cared for deeply every step of the way. He was 71 years old. Funeral Services will be held on Friday, August 8, 2025, at 2:00 p.m. at Watson-Hunt Funeral Home in Perry, Georgia. A Celebration of Life will be held at The Grove Church, 120 Langston Road, Perry, immediately following the service. A private interment will take place in Glen Haven Memorial Gardens. 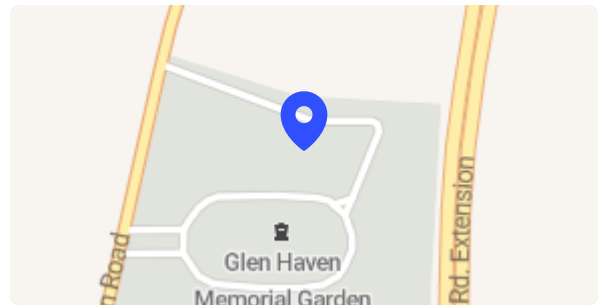
