Scotty L. Green, 67, of Dumas, Texas, passed away peacefully on Friday, November 28, 2025. Visitation will begin at 1:00 p.m., followed by a memorial service at 2:00 p.m. on Friday, December 5, 2025, at Henderson Baptist Church in Elko, Georgia. Pastor Corry Craine of Warren Church in Augusta will officiate, with additional remarks from Pastor Kyle Woodfin of Henderson Baptist Church.
