Ginger Lynn Stokes Woodell passed away unexpectedly on Wednesday, December 31, 2025. She was 42 years old. Funeral Services will be held on Thursday, January 8, 2026, at Watson-Hunt Funeral Home in Perry. Visitation will begin at 2:00 p.m., and the Funeral will begin at 3:00 p.m. Interment will be in Perry Memorial Gardens immediately following the service.

Ginger was born in Perry on March 2, 1983. The youngest of six, she basically grew up as an only child, because all of her siblings were so much older than her.
