William “Mack” Rainey, 76, passed away peacefully on January 9, 2026, with his loving family by his side. Mack was baptized later in life at The Vine Church of Houston County, where he was an active member until his health prohibited him from attending. His faith was an important part of his life, providing him with community and comfort.

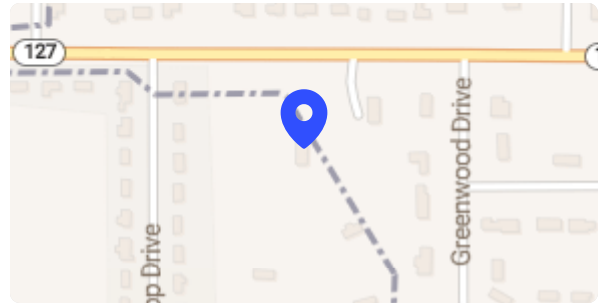

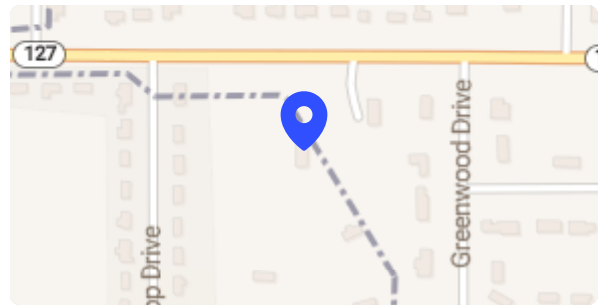
