Phillip “Craig” Stamps, 57, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, April 14, 2026, after an extended illness. Services will be held on Sunday, April 26, 2026, at Watson-Hunt Funeral Home, 1208 Main Street, Perry, Georgia.
