Tommie loved and enjoyed spending time with her children, of whom she was so proud, and her grandchildren, especially taking the 3 grandsons to the movies when they were younger. Through the years, she became quite involved and a strong believer in several philanthropic causes including Samaritan's Purse, Alzheimer's Association, Pregnancy Crisis Center, and rescuing as many dogs as she could. She was a member of Broad Street Baptist Church and loved her church family. Tommie was preceded in death by her parents, Wermer and Lillian McClung; her brother, David Forehand; and her son-in-law, Marc Martin.
